## Dr. Mark Eckart—Director



Dr. Mark S.F. Eckart has two master's degrees, an earned doctorate from two different seminaries and did post-graduate studies at the University of Cincinnati. He has authored four books and has taught for thirty years at the collegiate level. Dr. Eckart has served as Vice-President of a college, pastored several years, preached numerous revivals, was named to the National Dean's List for Academic Excellence, and listed in Who's Who in the Midwest. As an ordained minister in The Wesleyan Church, he serves as the District Superintendent in the Indiana South District and on the Board of Trustees at Indiana Wesleyan University. Mark and his wife, Debbie have three children.

## Rev. Glenn D. Black—Professor



Rev. Glenn D. Black was ordained as a minister in The Wesleyan Church on July 22, 1974. He has pastored Wesleyan churches in Ohio and Indiana. He served as editor of *God's Revivalist* and as District Superintendent of the Kentucky District of The Wesleyan Church. He served as a member of the Board of Trustees at SWU and IWU and is presently the Chairman of the Board of Trustees at KMBC. He has a Bachelor of Religious Education degree from God's Bible School and a Master of Arts degree from Indiana Wesleyan University. In the Indiana South District, he has served as Asst. District Superintendent, editor of *Indiana South Wesleyan*, Family Camp Coordinator and has served on various committees and boards.

Rev. Joey Nelson currently lives in Ligonier, Indiana. He is the Lead Pastor at Stone's Hill Community Church where he has served for over thirteen years. He leads a multi-staff midsize congregation and serves as the President of New Community Initiatives (a non-profit group that renews and revitalizes the greater Ligonier area). He has over twenty years of combined pastoral and teaching experience and has been teaching at the Clergy Development for the Indiana South District for eight years. Pastor Nelson has an A.S. degree in information systems. He also has a B.A. in Pastoral Ministry and an M.A. in Biblical Studies. He is ordained in The Wesleyan Church.

## Rev. Mark Reed—Professor



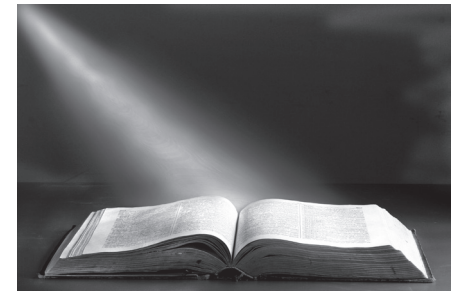

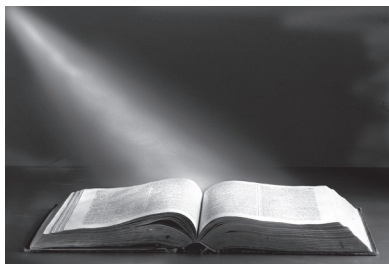
